CUNNAMULLA is part of the Paroo Shire and is located on the Warrego River in South West Queensland. The word 'Cunnamulla' means ' long stretch of water' or 'big waterhole' in the language of the Kunja people, the first occupiers of the region before European contact. The town was established in 1861 as a service for the cattle and sheep industries in the area. Although these industries as well as population have declined over the past 20 years, the town is developing a tourism industry which is very important to the town's survival.







According to the Census of Population and Housing: Socio economic indexes for areas (SEIFA) Australia, Cunnamulla in the low socio-economic range. There is a high unemployment rate and a high proportion of indigenous residents.

Even though the Paroo Shire Council is the town's largest employer, Cunnamulla is viewed as a 'welfare town' with little incentive for our youth to gain employment.

The community is involved in many strategic programs with local, state and federal agencies to turn this around.


The Paroo Shire Council Library's 'Glamour Photos Good Behaviour Initiative' though small, is part of the BIG picture.



- encourage school attendance 85% is a requirement of both schools.

- have school fees paid up by parents/caregivers.
- have students as active library members.
- have students participating in the After School Reading Club.





